We will be marking Holy Week by encouraging as many folk as possible to join together in worship, prayer and reading the bible. The following events will be taking place:

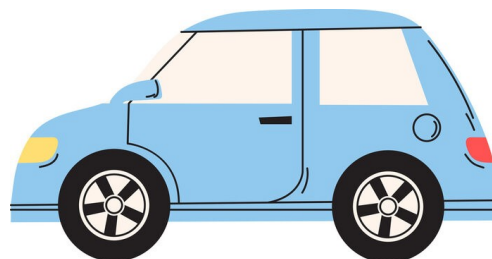
